Meeting of IQAC Cell of SAGEMMC, Bilaspur (C.G.) has been conducted on 09.01.2026. Action taken report of previous meeting dated on 03-11-2023 and minutes of meeting are as given below:-

Action Taken Report on the basis of IQAC meeting on 03-11-2023

1. Five Value Added Courses were introduced in the session 2023-24, which received great response from students.
2. In the session 2024-25, National Education Policy was introduced as per the guidelines of CG Higher Education and a pool of Skill Development Courses (SEC) were introduced.

Approval of work done after establishment of College

1. Overall three interactive panels have been installed in the college for the ICT based teaching and learning, among which two of the interactive panels have been granted from MLA fund by Shri Amar Agrawal, MLA Bilaspur.
2. The college received fund of Rs 2 lakhs for the purchase of furniture by District collector under DMF.
3. Fencing & maintenance of our college garden had been patronized by Smt. Jyoti Agrawal, Director, Rashi Steel plant under CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility).
4. Our Public Participation Committee Chairman (Jánbhagidari Adhyaksh) Shri Nandlal Choudhary donated 20 plastic chairs for library.
5. A college canteen has been established by the college for which curtains and furniture have been purchased.
6. Under Best-practice, students have prepared a box for collection and recycling of used pens and thus helping in the reduction of plastic garbage and encouraging reuse of objects.
7. A vending machine and an incinerator have been installed in the girls' washroom.
8. A separate room has been set up as Girls' common room where girls can make use of their leisure time. Potraits of renounced women personalities have been mounted on walls to inspire students. Useful reading materials are also available in the girls' common room.
9. In order to promote teaching and academic activities, a MoU has been signed with the Science College, Bilaspur & Arena Multi Media by our Computer Science and Computer Application departments respectively.


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10. An in-house website of our college has been meticulously created by our college faculty member Prakash Kumar Tripathi. This helps in circulation of regular updates regarding college while also reducing the additional expense required to maintain the website.
11. For quality improvement, staff members are also granted permission for attending Faculty Development Programme, conferences and workshops.
12. Teaching members are engaged in research activities and research papers are being published by them. Two patents have been granted to our faculty member Prof. Prakash Kumar Tripathi.
13. Poor students Welfare Committee has been formed and Rs. 10 is collected from each student for this purpose. A notice will soon be circulated among students, so that needy students can get some financial aid.
14. A 'Srijan Corner' has been assigned where students can showcase their talents.
15. A 'Chattisgarh Darshan' space has been created where students have showcased their talents in painting and it is still in progress.
16. For the first time, the college has taken the initiative to publish a College Magazine where both, faculty members and students, can submit their articles, stories, poems, etc. on various topics, ranging from social issues, current affairs, or motivational incidents.

After the approval of prior work done, under the umbrella of IQAC, the following decisions were taken to be implemented in the upcoming session:

1. Since SAGEMMC is the only English Medium Model College in the district, in order to provide PG courses to the UG qualifying students in the present session (UG final year) proposal must be sent to the government for major streams [such as MA in English Lit., M.A. In Pol. Sc., MA in History, M-Com, M.Sc. (C.Sc.) etc.] according to their feasibility and scope.
2. The following measures were also suggested by members of IQAC namely Harish Kedia, Dr. Praveen Rai, Jayesh Gumber, Nikhil Jivnani, Gurmeet Chawla, Smt. Anamika Tiwari :-
 - a. *Mr. Harish Kedia, with the consent of other respected members, offered to provide possible help in facilitating industrial partnership regarding internship for the students.*
 - b. *It was suggested that commerce students could be sent to a chartered accountant (CA) for guidance for future endeavours.*
 - c. *Also a proposal to send Biology students to factories manufacturing medicines was also made.*
 - d. *It was also suggested that political science students could be sent to political leaders for enhancing their leadership skills and understanding governance.*

- e. For learning marketing skills, a suggestion was tabled, to encourage partnership of college with private firms, companies etc.
- f. It was also suggested that, to promote the startup culture, the students must be shown TV series such as *Shark Tank India* and make them submit reports based on their understanding of the episode which can be considered as their assignments as well.

3. Mr. Nikhil Jivnani has suggested creation of a separate cell (Start Up cell) for the students where they can share innovative business ideas.
4. Student members of IQAC have suggested making maximum possible availability of e-library resources in the College.
5. Members also suggested organizing a placement camp for UG final year students.

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
